A pastel portrait has a dynamic three dimensional quality that far surpasses the static flatness of a photograph. She loves the tactile nature of working with soft pastels and the way that, by rubbing each layer onto the paper, she almost "strokes" the subject into life. She concentrates on wildlife an animal portraits.

The Aim of the workshop will be to create a beautifully detailed wildlife piece of artwork.

There will be an additional £5 on the day if the student wishes to use Teresa's pastels and paper.
